

Caño Negro Ecological

The diversity that comprises Caño Negro wetlands is one of the most peculiar in the country and the continent, due to the influence of air currents that it receives from both oceans and the existing water dynamics.

This wetland also works as a continental corridor or biogeographic bridge for large mammals and birds that migrate from the north to the south of the Americas and vice versa, allowing these lands to be an excellent site to appreciate wildlife.



The tour within the wetlands will allow you to navigate the Frío river, the canals and lagoons from the comfort of a boat that has all the safety standards, as well as knowing every detail of the impressive composition of this ecosystem and its community interaction.

Among the animals that can be appreciated are the kingfishers, caimans, turtles, Anhingas, iguanas, Howler monkey, Spider monkey, and White-throated monkey, herons, basilisks, among others.
