The diversity of frogs that can be found in Caño Negro is made up of some species that inhabit plants and others that spend most of their time in the water. Some are large and some are small, some with bright colors and others with more discreet colors.

On an active night, frogs can make us deafen with their joined songs at a climax moment.



Among the frogs that can be appreciate in the area are Common Dink Frog (*Diasporus diastema*), Savage's Bull Frog (*Leptodactylus savageii*), Red-eyed Leaf Frog (*Agalychnis callidryas*), Hourglass Treefrog (*Dendropsophus ebraccatus*), Snouted Treefrog (*Scinax boulengeri*), Rainforest Frog (*Lithobates vaillanti*) and many other.

These small and awesome animals in part breathe through their skin, which makes them indicators of the environment condition. In addition, due to their sensitivity they can suffer massive damage or death if there is any alteration or contamination in the environment.
